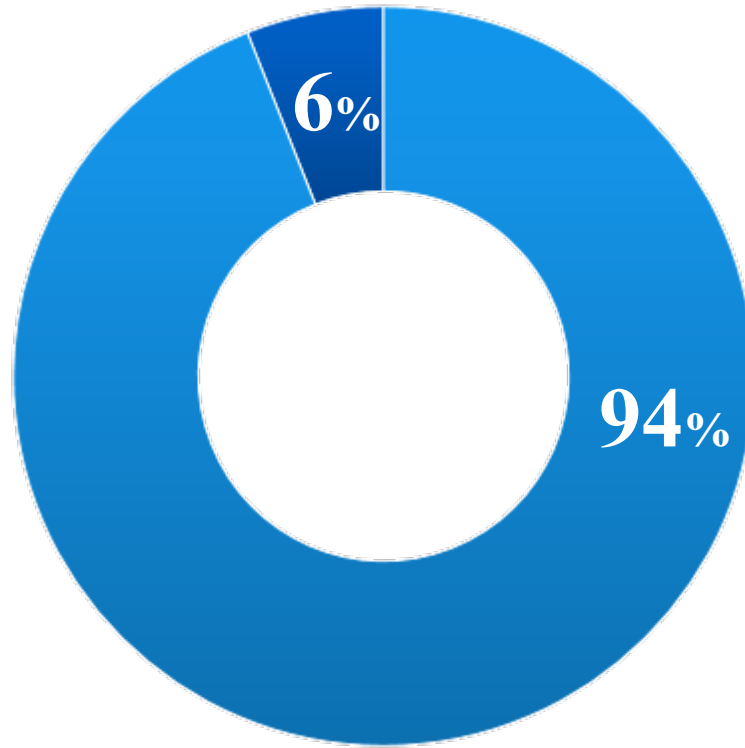

Abortion is common

1 in 4

Pre-Dobbs: Most abortions occurred early



■ ≤ 13 weeks ■ > 13 weeks

Pre-Dobbs: Safety

Condition	Death per 100,000
Abortion	0.41
Miscarriage	1
Marathon	0.6-1.2
Dental procedures	0-1.7
Plastic surgery	0.8-1.7
Childbirth	23*

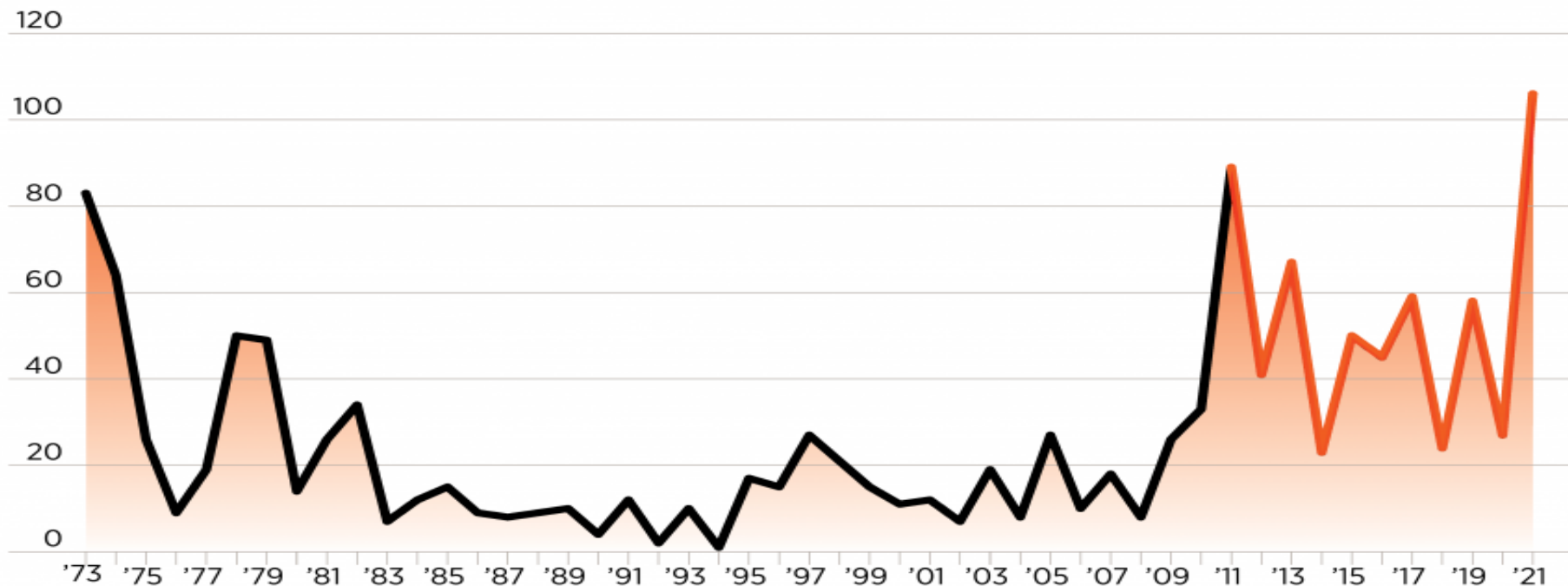

U.S. states have enacted 1,336 abortion restrictions since *Roe v. Wade* was decided in 1973

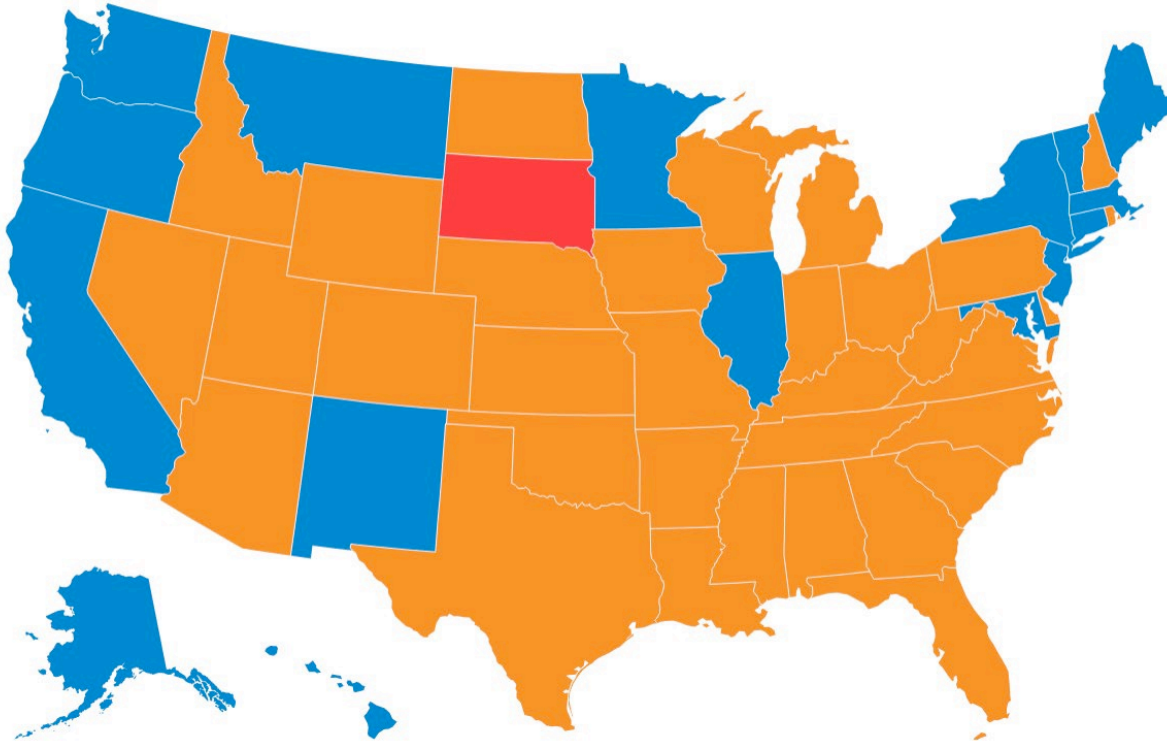
44% of those restrictions were enacted in the last decade alone

No. of restrictions enacted per year, as of Sept. 17, 2021



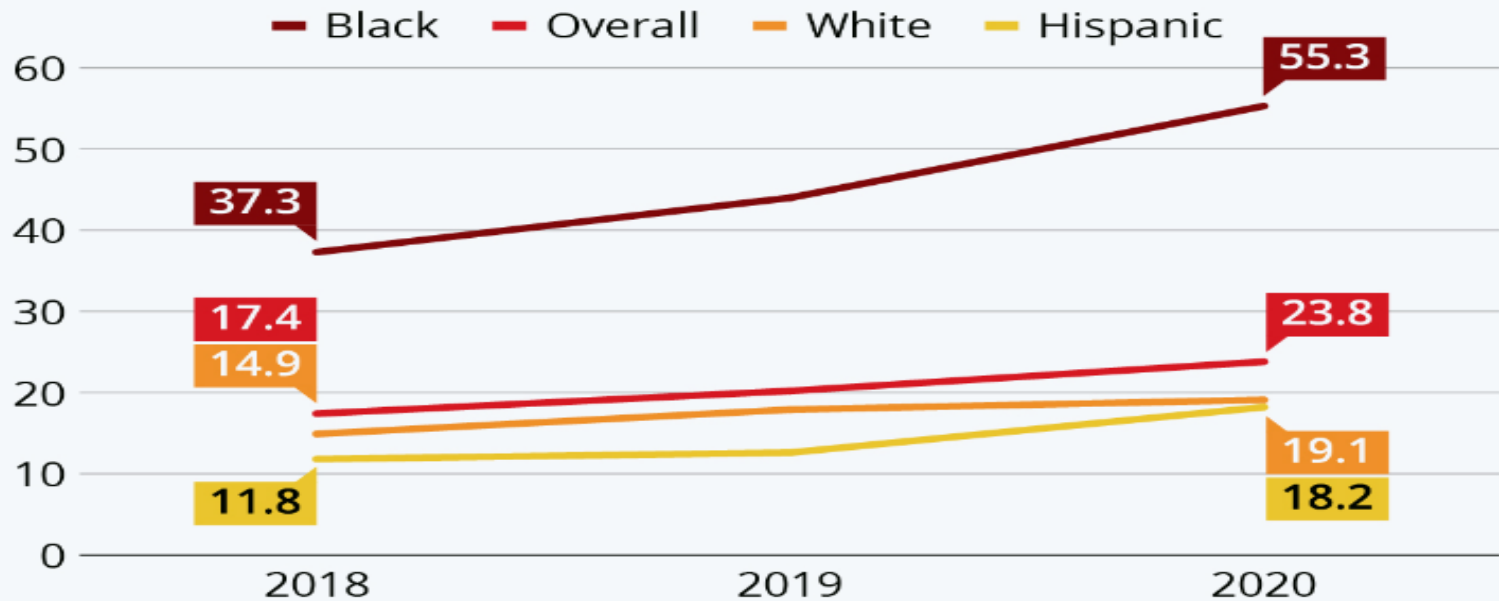
The Hyde Amendment

■ State uses own funds to pay for abortions under Medicaid (16 states) ■ State follows Hyde Restrictions (33 states & DC) ■ State is more restrictive than Federal Standard (1 state)

Restrictions Worsen Socioeconomic Outcomes

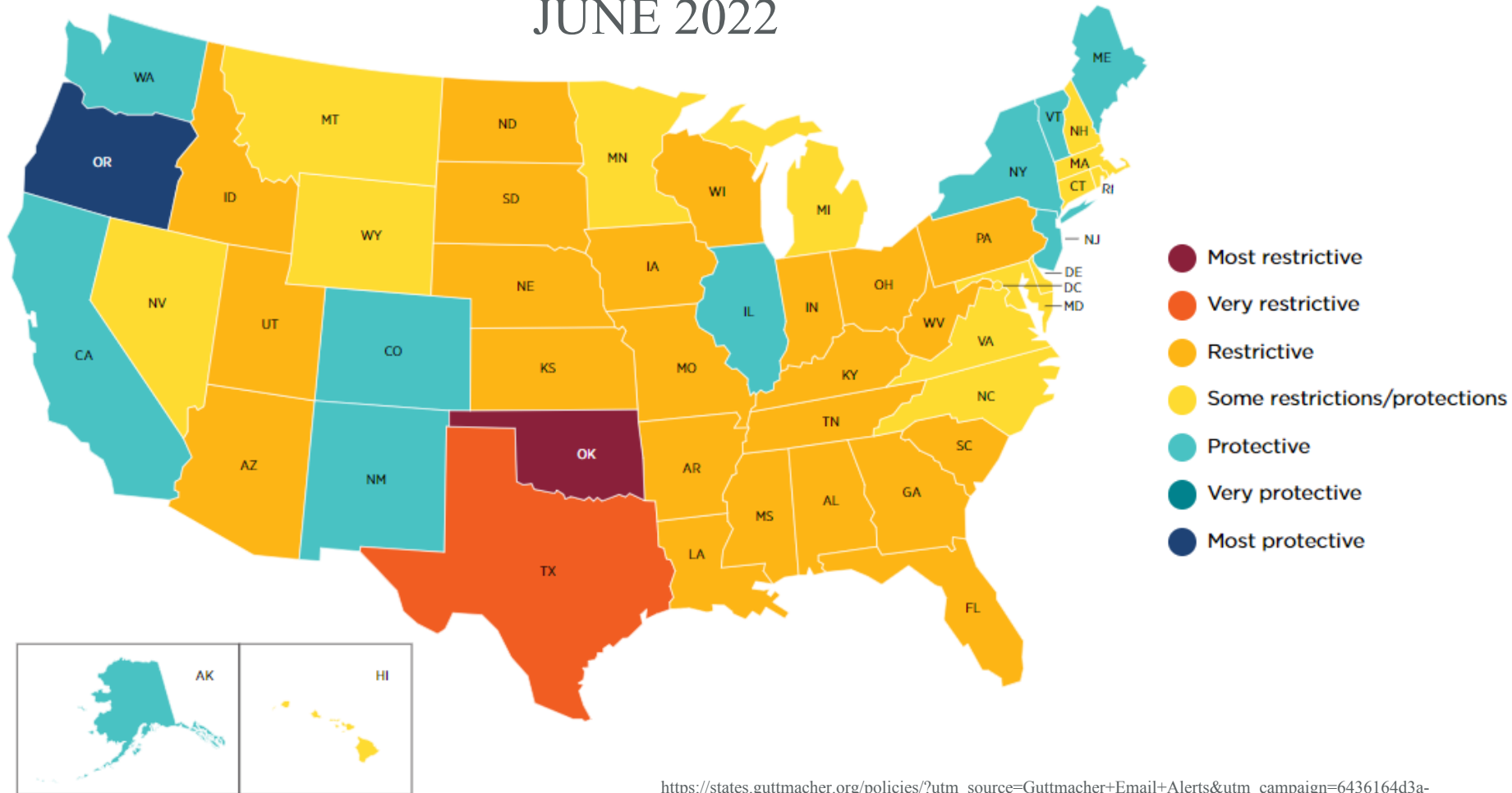
Turnaway Study

If denied abortion, more likely...

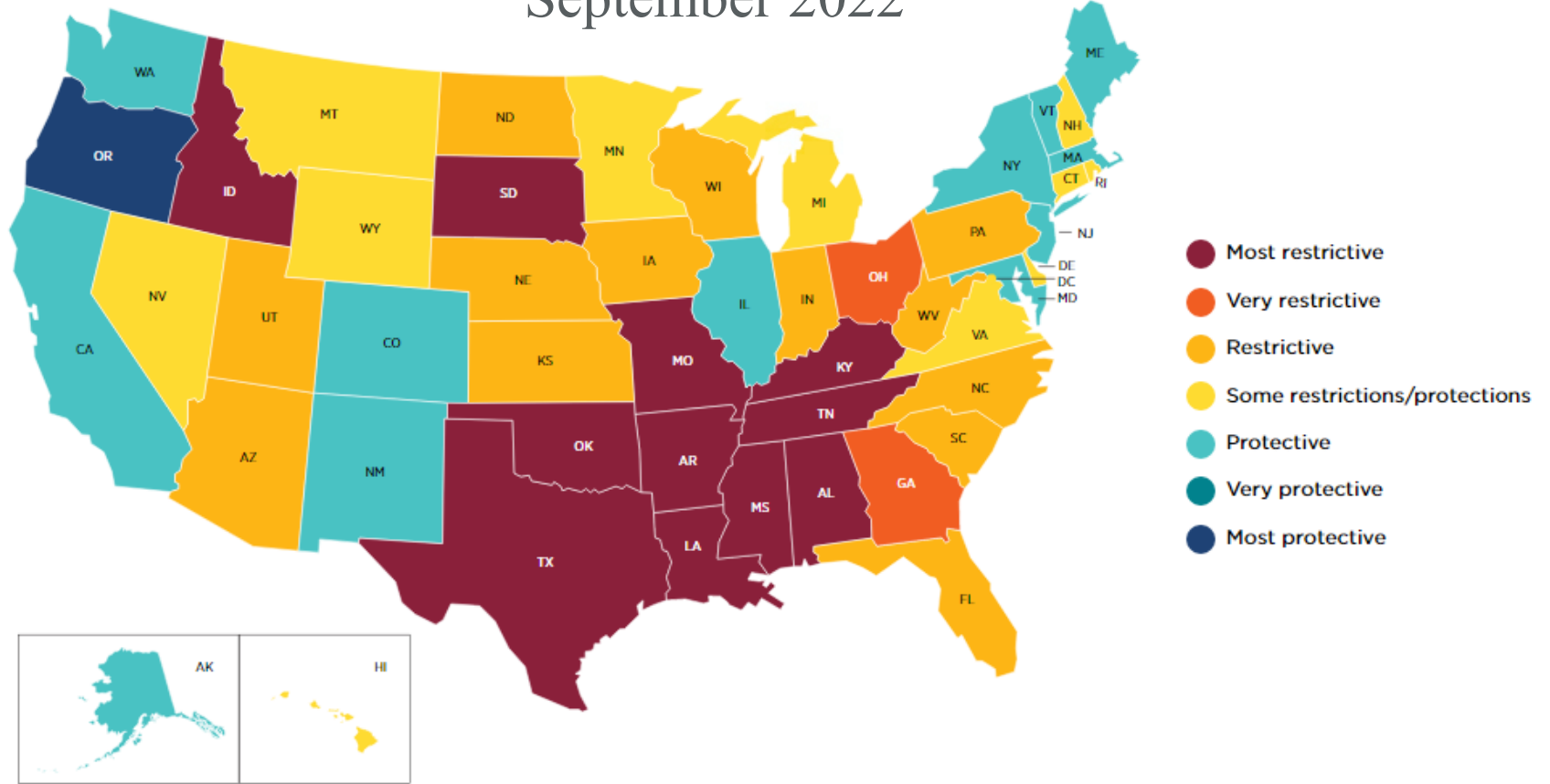
- To live in poverty up to 4 years after denial
- To be unemployed
- To rely on public assistance
- To parent alone
- To have contact with abusive partner
- To have lower mean child development scores
- To have children living in poverty

S.B. 8

- Illegal if “cardiac” activity
- Medical emergency
- No provision: rape/incest
- Civil enforcement: by anyone

H.B. 1280

- Criminal penalties

S.B. 1309

- Illegal after 6 weeks
- Provision for rape/incest if reported to the law
- Civil enforcement: biological relatives of pre-born
- Criminal charges
- Cannot advertise abortion service

H.B. 4327

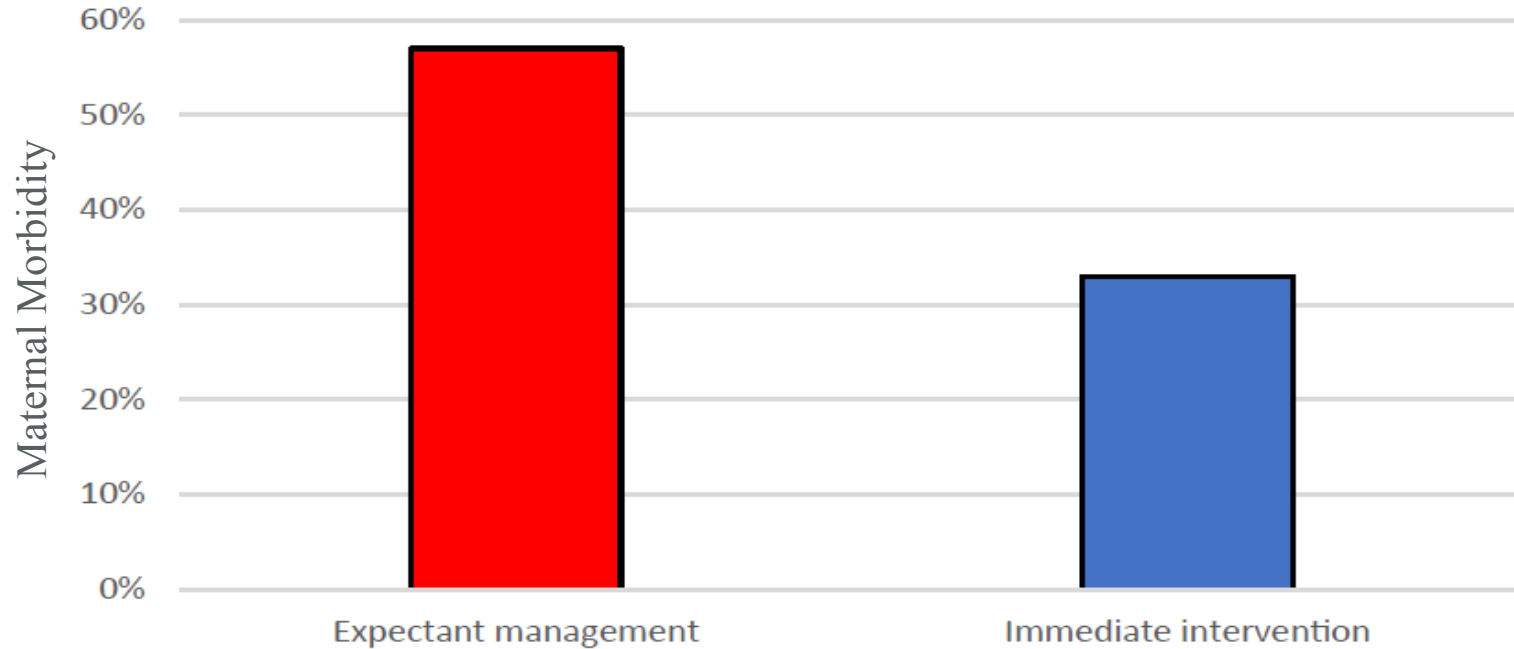
- Illegal at conception
- No provision: rape/incest
- Civil enforcement: by anyone
- Criminal charges



Loss of Access

- States with complete or severe bans experienced closure of all clinics since July 2022
 - Alabama (previously 5 clinics)
 - Arkansas (previously 2 clinics)
 - Mississippi (previously 1 clinic)
 - Missouri (previously 1 clinic)
 - Oklahoma (previously 5 clinics)
 - South Dakota (previously 1 clinic)
 - Texas (previously 23 clinics)

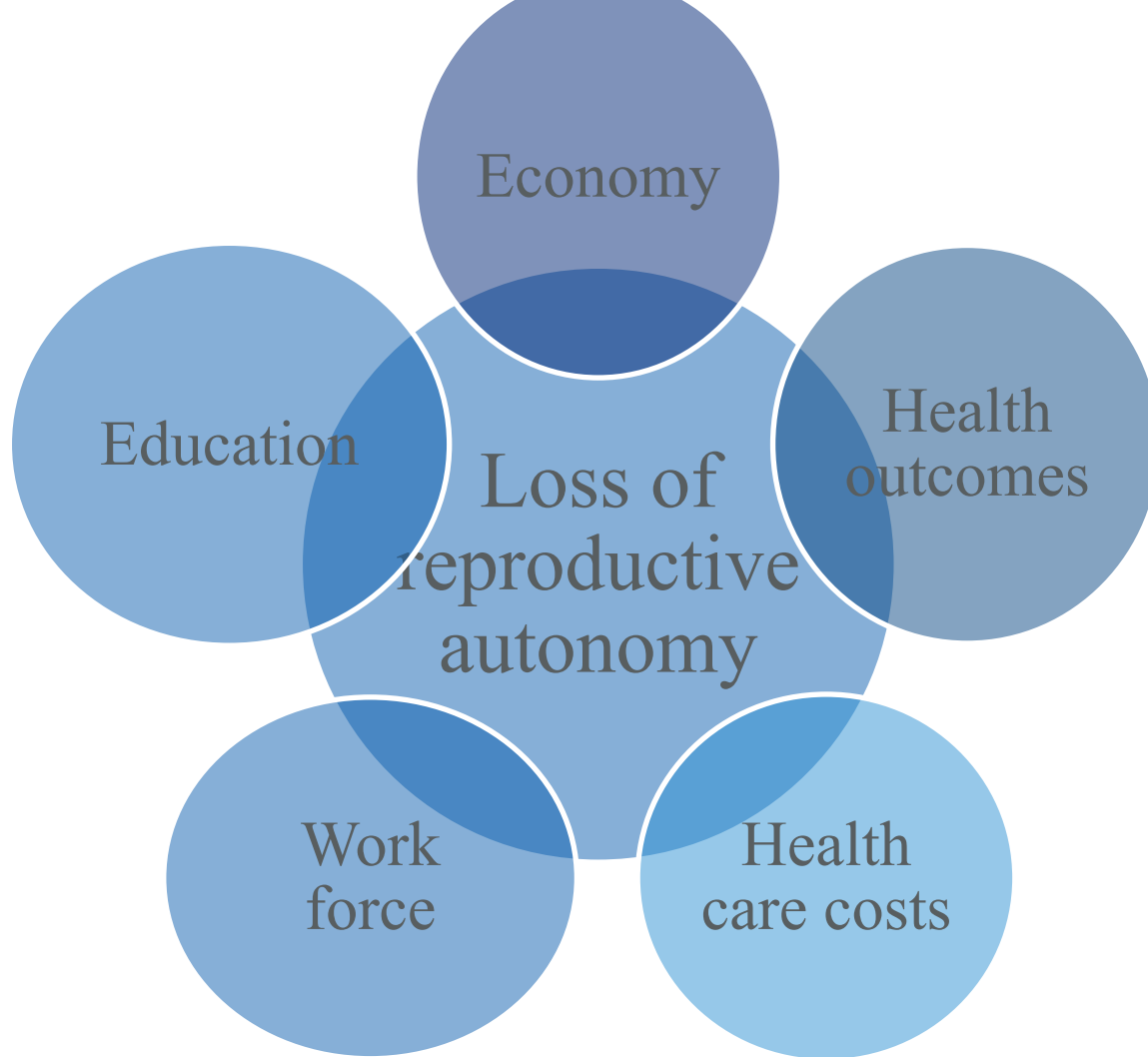
Texas outcomes with criminalization of abortion (Sept 2021-May 2022)
